**1. TEAM ELIGIBILITY**

A. Each team will be allowed 12 players per age group. A complete roster of these players must be submitted by the specified due date. Eligibility Cards and a signed Code of Conduct will be required.

<b>B. AGE GROUPS:</b>	Midgets (6 - 9)	8 Ft. Goal - 6 Minute Quarters
	Juniors (10 - 12)	10 Ft. Goal - 7 Minute Quarters
	Seniors (13 - 15)	10 Ft. Goal - 8 Minute Quarters

**2. PLAYER ELIGIBILITY**

A. Players must be members in good standing at their respective club/center at least 90 days before tournament. Remember you are responsible for your Club's behavior.

B. Age will be determined as of January 1 of the year of the tournament.

C. Anyone who played on their 2010-2011 Junior Varsity High School or Varsity High School team is not eligible to play on any team.

D. Anyone who played on an AAU team from January 1, 2010 to the date of the Divisional Tournament is not eligible to play on any team.

E. A birth Certificate must be submitted for each individual player by the specified tournament registration date. Anyone not having a birth certificate on file will not be able to play.

F. Each team must consist of at least 5 players with pictured ID to be eligible to play in tournament.

G. Upon arrival at team registration, **EVERY INDIVIDUAL PLAYER must present a picture ID that has been produced by either the DMV or Local School System to be eligible to play at the event. NO PICTURE ID, NO PLAYER REGISTRATION!!!!!!**

### 3. TOURNAMENT FACTS

- A. There will be one Divisional Tournament:  
GREENSBORO, NORTH CAROLINA
- B. All players competing must be outfitted with suitable clothing. Shirts must follow official number system, with no number over 5, i.e., 55. but not 16, is acceptable. When you are sending in your information to the sectional host, please send uniform colors and numbers of each player so the host will know to have pennies available.
- C. Each team's coach must present his/her line-up including numerals to the official scorer at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the game.
- D. The home and visitor team will be designated by the toss of a coin. Designated benches will be assigned.
- E. The official book will be the final and accurate score.
- F. Host shall supply the official scorer, two referees and one timer. A fee will be paid to all these services.
- G. Official basketball rules governing High School play will apply to juniors and seniors.
- H. Host club/center will provide all basketballs for warm-ups and games. Clubs/centers should not bring their basketballs.
- I. It was approved that each club/center must have a high impact staff member, i.e., director or commanding officer present to make sure there are no problems.
- J. Balls:

Midgets	Woman's Ball	28.6" Cir.
Juniors	Adult Men's Ball	30" Cir.
Seniors	Adult Men's Ball	30" Cir.
- K. Games are played with a "running clock." Until the **last two minutes of EACH HALF**, the clock will stop at **EVERY DEAD BALL.**
- L. Lane Violations Will Go As Follows:

Midgets	(6 - 9)	5 Seconds
Juniors	(10 -12)	3 Seconds
Seniors	(13 -15)	3 Seconds
- M. Midgets: The offensive team must have the opportunity to bring the ball across the half court line. The defensive team must set-up inside the three point arc until the ball passes half court and then the defense can play any defense it wants. Midgets will only be allowed to press last two minutes of fourth quarter.

N. No Dunking Will Be Allowed on 8 ft. goals!!!

O. Time Outs:

Midgets (6 - 9)	3 (30 Second Time Outs)
Juniors (10 -12)	3 (1 Minute Full Time Outs) 2 (30 Second Time Outs)
Seniors (13 -15)	3 (1 Minute Full Time Outs) 2 (30 Second Time Outs)

**5. CONDUCT/BEHAVIOR –**

A. Conduct of players, coaches and fans cannot be emphasized too strongly. The first purpose of the tournament is fellowship; second is outcome of the game. It would be wise for all participants to conduct themselves as Christians. The Tournament Director reserves the right to ask any individual conducting themselves in an obnoxious manner to leave the building.

B. **CODE OF CONDUCT** - At the September 1980 Quarterly Meeting a ruling was approved that "everyone participating in any Divisional Event must read and sign the Code of Conduct" on the back. (Copy herewith attached).

C. **Excessive Celebration - A Technical Foul will be called for excessive celebration. I.e. Jumping up and bumping chests.**

**6. OFFICIALS**

A. Officials must be currently sanctioned by the State High School Athletic Association. Basketball scorers and timekeepers must be at least 16 years old. Games involving host teams must be scored and timed by adults. The official score is the final score.

**7. TEAM CERTIFICATION**

A. Rosters, Shirt Size and Registration fee must be RECEIVED BY SET DATE. Clubs/centers not complying with these rules will be disqualified from the event in question.

B. Game time is forfeit time as well as late registration time.

- C. Forfeit of Games:  
A team will be penalized for forfeiting games after roster has been sent to host:
1. Absorb cost of officiating \$50.00 per Game.
  2. This includes late arrival Forfeit
  3. Notify corps officer and council chairman that this behavior will not be tolerated.
- D. Any team allowing an ineligible player to play in the event will be banned from playing in ANY, AND ALL Divisional Event for three years.
- E. Upon arrival at team registration, EVERY INDIVIDUAL PLAYER must present a picture ID that has been produced by either the DMV or Local School System to be eligible to play at the event. NO PICTURE ID, NO PLAYER REGISTRATION!!!!!!
- F. Every roster must include a signature page from the Executive Director and the Commanding Officer verifying that all information is true to their knowledge.
- G. **Teams must be registered between 4:30pm and 6:30pm on **Friday** at the Simkins Sports Pavilion at Barber Park t • 1500 Dans Road • Greensboro NC • 336-373-4676, or the team will take their first loss.**
- H. Teams wishing to change and update rosters must pay an additional \$20 fee for each participant changed after March 2, 2011. Payment must be received before the change will be made.
